



## Important Information about Doggie PlayCare

Doggie PlayCare is supervised off leash play with other dogs. It offers numerous benefits for your dog including: socialization, exercise, manners with dogs and humans, basic training, bite inhibition, and more. The Palms offers indoor and outdoor areas for play. Dogs in our pack have been temperament tested to ensure the safety for all. The temperament test measures attitudes and serves as a tool for evaluating how a dog might act and react in various situations.

Our hours are Monday through Friday 7:00 am- 6:00 pm. Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays are big dog days. Small dogs must to be approved for these days by our staff to ensure their safety with the bigger dogs. Tuesdays and Thursdays are small dog days for dogs 30 lbs. or less. Some larger dogs may be allowed these days if approved by staff. Dogs need to be dropped off by 9am for any playcare day. Please call ahead and make a reservation.

*Note: If your pet misses more than 3 consecutive months we will have to re-temperament test them*

### First Day Checklist! Did you....

- Complete the attached Personality Profile. **We must have this form 3 DAYS PRIOR to 1<sup>st</sup> visit.**
- Show proof from your veterinarian of the following vaccinations:
  - Rabies
  - Bordetella given within the past 6 months
  - Parvo/Distemper (DHLPP)
  - Negative fecal within the past year.
- \*If bordetella is not current, we like it to be done at least one week before playcare.
- Make a reservation to schedule your temperament test on the appropriate day.
- Dogs 6 months or older must be spayed or neutered and puppies must be 8 weeks or older to start playcare.
- Drop off is between 7:00am-8:00am
- A quick release snap collar is required for safety. (Buckle, Martingale, Prong, choke chains, or harnesses are not permitted). Snap collars are available in our boutique if you wish to purchase one at The Palms.
